Thema: *"Reconsidering Jewish Migration from Muslim Countries: A Socio Spatial Perspective from Morocco"*

Jews constituted an integral part of Moroccan society for centuries. In the two decades after 1948 the near entirety of Moroccan Jewry had left their country of origin. Traditional and popular narratives define these and other MENA Jewish migrations as homogenous ethnic displacements stemming directly from the 'Arab-Israeli' conflict. To offer a fresh perspective, I will pay attention to sub-regional differences within Morocco and delve deeper into how these mobile communities understood their own displacements. This discussion helps advance the scholarship beyond narratives of 'mass departures' that dominate the study of Jewish-Muslim relations in the mid-20th century.
